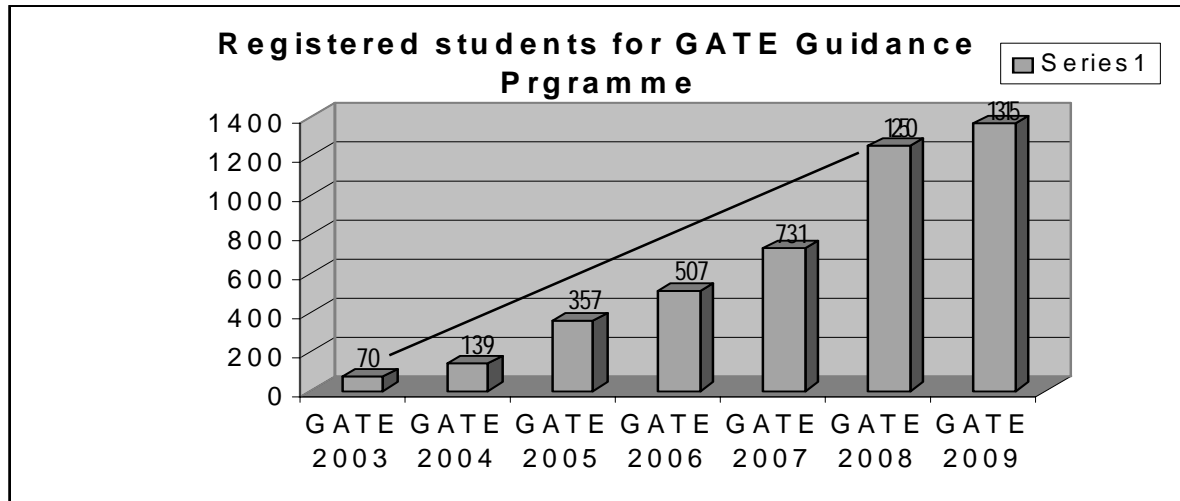


**FAQs about our CAREER GATE/PG Entrance Guidance Programme in Pune****Q. 1) What does the CAREER GATE/PG Entrance - 2010 Guidance Programme- Pune offer ?**

Ans.: There are three components of this programme.

- 1) Teaching Component
- 2) Syllabus based Practice Tests
- 3) Study Material

**Q. 2) What is the schedule of Teaching programme ?**

Ans.: There will be minimum **12** teaching sessions in Pune spread throughout the year.

In these teaching sessions experienced faculty members will interact with the students with the objective of

- 1) Explaining important concepts of the topics included in syllabus and study strategy for GATE.
- 2) Guiding the students to various reference material.
- 3) Helping students to remain on proper track of GATE preparation.

We will be giving additional intensive teaching inputs at Nashik through **13 Days Residential CAREER GATE/PG Entrance-2010 Guidance Programme (Winter Vacation/Christmas Vacation)**

**Q. 3) What is the schedule of GATE/PG Entrance Practice Tests ?**

Ans. : We have divided GATE syllabus into 6 equal parts and based on that we have prepared a set of 18 tests.

- 12 Tests are based on 6 equal parts of GATE syllabus.
- 2 Mid-Term revision tests.
- 4 Full Length tests covering entire GATE syllabus.

**Q. 4) How will be the tests evaluated ?**

Ans. : Evaluation of tests is an important aspect of this test series. The tests will be evaluated according to GATE pattern and even the percentile score will be calculated. Knowing your percentile score will help you in improving your strategy for GATE/PG ENTRANCE This will give proper direction to your studies.

**Q. 5) How is the percentile score calculated ?**

Ans. : For calculating the percentile score we rank the students from all centres and by using a correction factor we calculate a percentile score for each student. Last year we had a database of 1315 students from all over India. We have improve our methodology from last year in test series which is regarding the wrong Questions, in this process we are sending the question Nos of wrong questions which are attempt wrong answer by student for the respective test. after receiving the reanswer of respective questions by student. we are again let you know that which answers are correct solve by student. This method is useful to student for decrease the percentage of negative mark & get high score in competitive exam.

**Q.6) Will provide answer key of GATE Practice Test Papers ?**
